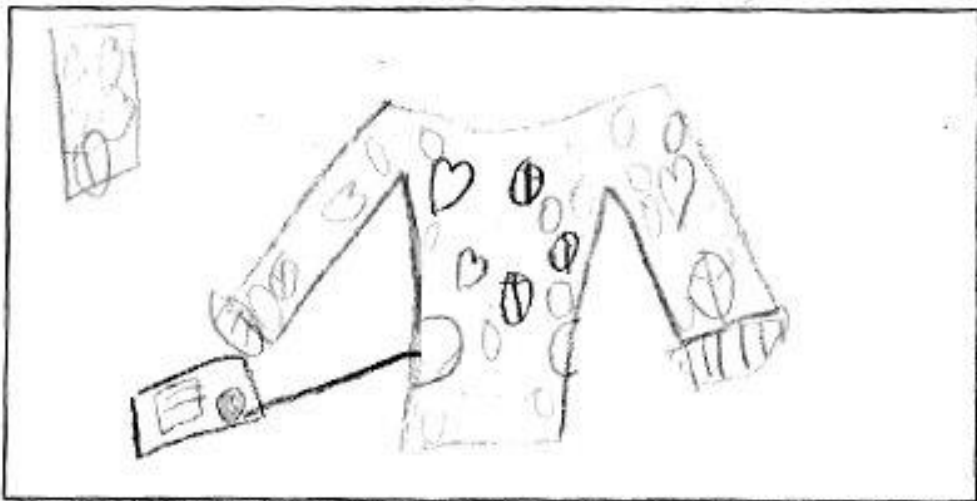

Title of Invention: A Poop Scooper

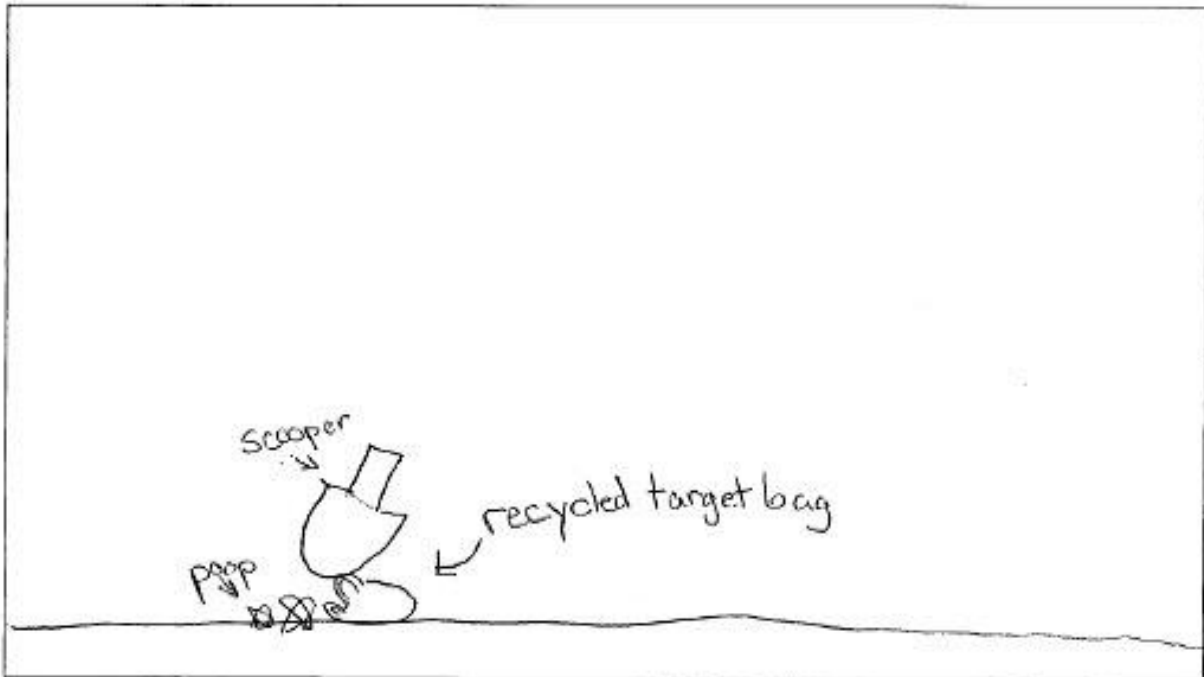
Problem Statement:
